## WHEN?

The course will run from Sunday August 21 to Wednesday August 24.

### WHERE?

This will be an opportunity to meet with British Council and local trainers on **a 3 day residential course** to be held at **Bebrene General Education and Vocational Secondary School in Latgale**. Room and Board and transportation costs are covered.

#### WHAT?

This will be a chance to improve your practical language and computer skills as well as to learn about British Council initiatives to facilitate teachers' professional development and to promote inclusive learning. Networking with colleagues from all over Latvia will also result in useful contacts and good ideas. British Council trainers will concentrate on aspects of teaching CLIL and considerations when teaching Special Needs students as well as looking at how teachers can enhance their own professional development. Language Awareness and making more effective use of IT in the classroom will also be themes that will be addressed. We aim to make the course as practical as possible so that you can immediately use these ideas in the classroom. Fun and games are also guaranteed.
